### The Position:

Bolt Biotherapeutics has an opportunity for technician to help manage and maintain our animal facility that supports Bolt's cutting-edge science and preclinical and clinical development of its unique ISAC platform. The Vivarium Technician follows established practices and procedures to provide routine animal care and husbandry and assists research staff in performing technical work related to the care and use of research animals. This position will report to a Senior Scientist.

### About You:

You will help support the daily care of animals and maintain the vivarium in accordance with IACUC regulations, other applicable laws, company standard operation procedures. You have previous experience performing daily mouse checks and able to recognize and communicate any animal health problems to supervisor in a timely manner. Experienced with keeping records on animal health, temperature and humidity, and animal receipt. You are comfortable ordering, receiving, and logging animals into inventory. In addition, you are experienced with ordering and maintaining vivarium supplies such as caging materials, food, syringes, and collection tubes. Additional skills including but not limited to:

- 3+ years' experience working with animals and a minimum high school diploma or equivalent
- Flexibility in work hours which will include weekends and holidays
- Basic computer skills such as inputting data into spreadsheets and scanning bar codes.
- Maintain vivarium equipment such as cage racks, vaporizers, and surgical tools
- Routinely sanitize, mop, and sweep vivarium and remove waste from the vivarium
- Collect fecal, oral, and/or fur samples for routine animal health monitoring
- Change cages, water bottles, lids, and other items weekly
- Participate in IACUC meetings
- May assist in general lab duties and animal studies
